New Business

Last month, the Board of Education approved restructuring the debt service for the High School District. Board President Trogel thanked Mr. Wayne Loper, Asst. Superintendent for Finance & Operations as being a major player and for his hard work, in saving the District more than \$1,000,000 over the next five years thru this restructuring.

Board President Trogel presented a plaque to outgoing Board President Jacobs and thanked Trustee Jacobs for a great year as Board President. Superintendent's Report

Information and Exploration

Staff Recognition: Nassau Counselors Association Exemplary Practice Award in Guidance

Dr. Bernstein introduced Jill Vogel, District Director of Guidance to the community. Ms. Vogel and her staff were recipients of the Nassau Counselors Association Exemplary Practice Award in Guidance. In particular, the Memorial Junior High School/Central High School College Day Program was submitted and chosen as the winner. This program assists 9th grade students in recognizing how important their high school transcript is when applying to colleges and involves presentations by colleges and high school seniors.

Capital Project Update

Mr. Loper gave the Board an update on the capital projects occurring within the district. The majority of the work is completed; however 3 major projects are still open. The air conditioning installation at Central High School is approximately 65% completed and should be done by September 30th. The installation of the elevator at the District Offices in Memorial Junior High School will begin September 28th and should be completed by the end of the year. The District wide telephone system has been designed and implementation should begin in December.

Parent Survey re Changes in Student Parking Protocols

The Board had a discussion last spring regarding student safety; in particular student driving at lunchtime. Dr. Bernstein stated that all too often, you read about a school tragedy involving a student driver during their lunchtime. When this occurs, the community immediately wants the campus closed. Dr. Bernstein feels that the District should be proactive and modify options given to the students; not closing the campus but not allowing students to take their cars out of the lots during school hours. Parking on campus is a privilege given to the students by the Board of Education and options can be looked at.

A parent survey was developed to ask for their opinion. This survey was discussed with the Parent groups at their September meetings. The District Office will work with the building principals to distribute the paperwork. The survey will be available to complete on line as well as the hard copy being distributed. Parents can also view the Inside Edition segment regarding student driving where North High School students were filmed during their lunch hour. Student input will also be encouraged. This item will be back on the November, 2009 agenda.

September 8, 2009 – Business Meeting

Summer School 2009

Dr. Tracey Nekulak, Director of Summer School shared that 920 students enrolled in the academic and enrichment programs held during the summer. Of the 16 seniors enrolled, 15 graduated at the Summer School ceremony held in August. 32 incoming 7th graders, deemed academically at risk, attending the Jump Start program which reinforces math and reading skills. 796 students from grades 3 – 12 participated in the music program. Mr. Todd Holly coordinates the program for all of the Valley Stream schools. Dr. Nekulak thanked all of the staff for a job well done.

Residency Advisory Committee Meeting – either Monday, October 26, 2009 or Monday, November 2, 2009, 8:30 a.m., Board Room

Dr. Heidenreich asked those Board Members that were interested in attending the next Residency Advisory Committee Meeting, to let him know which date would work best for them.

Echocardiogram Screenings

About a year ago, Dr. Heidenreich addressed the Board regarding the District offering free echocardiogram screenings to 8th grade students. The hospital is available to do the screening on October 3rd. All 8th grade students will be notified and a press release will be issued.

District Website – New Look

The District website has looked the same for the past 7 – 8 years. Over the last 6 months, there has been much discussion as to how to revitalize the website. Frank Morisco, District Director of Administrative & Educational Technology, presented the new website which should launch in mid to late October.

Dr. Bernstein asked the Board for their input as he felt it is important that they have a say as to what the Board of Education would want on the website. Board President Trogel asked if there were any Board members interested in working with Mr. Morisco; Trustees Antonelli and Jacobs volunteered.

H1N1 Swine Flu – Preparations

Dr. Bernstein informed the Board and community that the District has been reviewing steps to help prevent the swine flu. There will be ample hand sanitizer available throughout the schools. A new cleaning protocol has been initiated in that surfaces that are touched more frequently (ie. doorknobs, handrails, etc.) than others will be wiped down more often during the day. The District is also looking at the cost factor of having more boxes of tissues available in classrooms. The website will be updated with H1N1 information as it becomes available.

The weekly calls with the Commissioner of Health and school superintendent's will begin again in late September.

9/11 Observance

As the District has done in past years, Dr. Bernstein has asked each Principal to make an announcement, sharing the history of what occurred on September 11, 2001, to remember the military fighting overseas to protect the United States against terrorism and to have moment of silence.

Trustee Stewart asked if the District had looked into the curriculum that was developed for high school students by a 9/11 family group? Dr. Bernstein responded that we hadn't but asked Trustee Stewart if he could find more information on it.

Attorney's Report

Greg Guercio, Attorney for the District presented a report regarding a recent decision in which the Commission of Education upheld a determination that a student was not a district resident entitled to attend the district's schools tuition-free and that the district's action in charging the parent tuition for the student's attendance was not arbitrary or unreasonable.

A copy of the report was given to the District Clerk for distribution to the Board.
