

Revised Reopening Plan – March 2022

- Schools will remain open for in-person learning.
- Traditional school schedules, including arrival and dismissal times, bell transitions, and locker room use will remain in place.
- Schools will not require daily health screenings; however, please stay home if you do not feel well!
- Schools will maintain three feet of social distancing where possible, including music, chorus, and athletic content areas.
- Masks and medical face coverings will be optional for indoor and outdoor instruction and activities.
- The District will continue to provide masks to anyone who needs one.
- Enhanced COVID cleaning protocols, as established last year, will continue to be followed.
- Future CDC, NYSDOH, and NCDOH recommendations or requirements will be adhered to, and any major changes will be conveyed to the school community.

Guidance: The District is cognizant that the regulations provided by the New York State Department of Health, CDC and other regulatory agencies are constantly changing in regards to masking, isolation, quarantine periods, etc. As such, please note the District will be adhering to the most current guidance provided by those agencies.

Test Kits: The District will continue to supply students and staff with test kits as long as supplies last. Please contact your building's main office should you require a kit. Test kits are used for screening purposes only and not diagnostic purposes.
