Cell Phone Infraction Data – 2025-2026

Pursuant to New York State law, each school district, charter school, and Board of Cooperative Educational Services (BOCES) is required to publish an annual report on its website detailing the implementation and enforcement of its Distraction-Free Schools Policy during the previous school year.

The initial report must be published no later than September 1, 2026, with subsequent reports published annually by September 1.

The report must include non-identifiable demographic information regarding students who received disciplinary action for violations of the policy, as well as an analysis of any demographic disparities in enforcement. If a statistically significant disparate impact is identified, the district must also include a mitigation action plan.

Based on a review of the district's enforcement data, disciplinary actions were proportionate to the district's overall student enrollment demographics. As no statistically significant demographic disparities were identified, a mitigation action plan and further disparity analysis are not required and are therefore not included in this report.
